Halton Hills, Ontario- The Ontario Minister of Long-Term Care, Dr. Merrilee Fullerton announced the investment of \$933 million in 80 new long-term care projects, which will lead to thousands of additional new and upgraded long-term care spaces across the province.

The planned redevelopment of the Bennett Centre Long-Term Care will see an increase of beds from 66 to a 160-bed, long-term care residence. This increase of 94 beds, will directly help address the lack of long-term care beds in North Halton and will support the needs of older adults (65+) population which is projected to double by 2031.

The proposed new Bennett Centre Long-Term Care Home will offer two specialized units; one 32 bed unit for residents with behavioural needs and a dedicated 32 bed Francophone unit. Bennett Centre Long-Term Care is one of seven long-term care homes approved to serve the growing Francophone population. It can ensure French speaking older adults in the area receive care in their first language which will improve their care experience and quality of life.
