In January we conducted a clothing audit of all our resident's rooms. Below is our analysis of the audit that was completed.

East Wing

68% of Rooms had unlabeled clothing items

32% of Rooms had no laundry issues

0 Rooms had clothing items belonging to another resident

North Wing

63% of Rooms had unlabeled clothing items

28% of Rooms had no laundry issues

4 Rooms had clothing items that belonged to another resident

- Any unlabeled items that were found were labeled and returned to the resident's room
- Any items that were found in the wrong room were returned to the proper room

A reminder to all family members that we encourage that all articles of clothing get labeled prior to being left in resident's rooms. Please see our Screener for a Resident Personal Item Form to be completed to prevent items from getting lost or misplaced.

Hand Hygiene for Visitors

Help prevent germ transmission. Cleaning your hands is the #1 way to prevent the spread of infectious agents.

- Clean your hands upon arriving at the front entrance of the home.
 - Clean your hands after changing your mask
 - Clean your hands before entering a resident room
 - Clean hands after assisting your loved one with any type of care.
 - If gloves are worn for care they must be removed before moving on to the next care task and hands must be sanitized when gloves are removed. Gloves are not permitted in the hall ways.
 - Clean your hands before leaving a resident room.
 - Clean your hands on your way out of the home.
- Alcohol based hand rub is the preferred method of hand hygiene unless hands are visibly soiled. Hands should be rubbed or washed for a minimum of 15 seconds
